Tournament Details

Hoop Dreams Tournament

The 10th Annual Hoop Dreams Tournament is an exciting daylong outdoor community festival and charity basketball competition. The event brings together D.C. public high school students and Washington DC metropolitan region business professionals, and other youth and adults from across the D.C. Metro region. The Tournament offers "open" competition, and does not seek to match teams by age, height or any other criteria. All skill levels are welcome. To provide more playing opportunity, the 2005 Tournament will feature a Consolation Bracket. Teams that lose their first scheduled game, are eligible. Prizes will be awarded to Consolation Bracket winners. Please note that a game won by forfeit may be counted as a "win" when determining if a team qualifies for the Consolation Bracket.

Entry Fee

\$80 per team. All teams must have 3 to 5 players to register. Proceeds benefit academic college scholarships and support programs for D.C. public high school students.

High School Student Teams

- Current DC public high school students, and those who graduated in May 2005 and who are 18 or younger as of June 18, 2005, and alumni of the Hoop Dreams Scholarship Fund program, who are currently enrolled in college or who have recently graduated from college, are eligible to play free-of-charge, however all students are encouraged to consider making a personal donation to Hoop Dreams.
- Groups of 3-5 students that may include current students and/or Hoops Dreams alumni can register as a team, or you can register individually and be assigned to a team. You must contact Theo Brannum at tbranum@hoopdreams.org or at (202) 289-6157 to participate free-of-charge.
- Others students and/or alumni who wish to sign up their own teams may do so on-line or by submitting a regular registration form and paying the normal \$80 per team fee.

- The Player Registration Event is for teams that have previously registered on-line or have previously mailed or faxed their registration form to Hoop Dreams; and for un-registered teams that wish to sign up, if space is available.
- Tournament registration is closed when 128 teams have signed up.
- All teams that have previously registered should send one or more representatives to pay the entry fee, if owed, and to pick up team t-shirts, wristbands and copies of the tournament rules. Each team captain should distribute these items to all team members before June 18, 2005.
- Check www.hoopdreams.org at 3:00 PM on June 15, 2005 to learn if additional teams can still be accommodated.
- If registration is still "open" at 3:00 PM on June 15, 2005
 un-registered teams should arrive at the Player Registration
 Event with a completed and signed registration form, a Waiver
 of Claim signed by all players, and a check or money order
 payable to the "Hoop Dreams Scholarship Fund" in the amount
 of \$80.
- If registration is closed on or before June 15, 2005, you may add your team to the Waiting List by bringing the above materials and payment to the Player Registration Event.

Waiting List

A Waiting List will be created if more than 128 teams wish to play. Wait List Teams that are physically "standing by" at the Tournament on Saturday, June 18, 2005 at 8:00 AM, ready to play, may be able to participate - if other teams fail to show up for their first game. Wait List Teams that are present, will be accepted in the order in which they appear on the Waiting List.

Age Limit

All players must be 15 years of age or older as of Saturday, June 18, 2005.

Official Tournament Rules

Conventional "Streetball" rules apply. All games will be officiated, and volunteers will serve as scorekeepers and timekeepers. Copies of the Official Tournament Rules are available on-line at www.hoopdreams.org, at the Player Registration Event on June 15, 2005 and at the tournament site.

Rain or Shine!

An **indoor** celebration will be held if the Tournament is cancelled in advance due to rain or the serious threat of heavy, extended rain, or other circumstances that prevents the event from occurring outdoors. This "replacement" event will also be held if the Tournament is cancelled on June 18th after it has started due to rain or other circumstances. The indoor celebration will feature free food, beverages and entertainment and everyone is welcome. A brief program honoring individuals and organizations that have had a positive impact on Hoop Dreams will be held.
